The year 2020 was a challenge for all of us. In addition to the Covid issues, Honduras had two hurricanes in November that devastated the country.

By the middle of March, Honduras was closed to American teams. At Promise Home, we tried many methods to minimize our exposure to the Covid disease. However, by the end of August half of our children and *tias* had the disease. God blessed us with no serious issues from Covid.

In October, the Christian school that our children were virtually attending closed permanently. Now two of our oldest children are in a virtual school out of El Progreso while eight of our children are being taught by a full-time teacher at Promise Home.

In November, two hurricanes two weeks apart hit Honduras causing major flooding. At Promise Home, our roads washed out and we had a section of our hillside wash out. We were blessed that with no other problems.

We look forward to 2021 and are hoping to be able to start hosting teams later in the year.

This year we have had to adjust to the changes that the Covid virus brings to all of us. Our last team for this year left in the middle of March. In Honduras, all public transportation has been shut down, all schools are still closed and unlike the US we still have many restrictions on shopping and other activities.

Our After School Program was put on hold in March and continues to stay on hold. Each month we provide the forty-four families in the program, a care package that has food and supplies to help their families cope with the high unemployment in our area.
